## Threat Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment Training

This course is designed for Emergency Management professionals to attend at **no cost**.

This course will help participants gain and enhance their knowledge. It introduces the process of identifying threats and hazards that stress a community's capabilities.

The session contextualizes those threats and hazards and identifies associated impacts consistent with specific factors. It also identifies community-specific capability targets, assesses current levels of ability compared to those targets, and identifies capability gaps and subsequent strategies to close them.

Using the POETE (Planning, Organization, Equipment, Training, and Exercises) areas, and incorporating this information into general planning.

Completion of the course will assist local emergency management efforts and stakeholders in generating actionable preparedness data that communities can use to support a variety of emergency management efforts, including planning, training, exercises, and incident response and recovery.

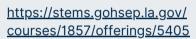
